

Transport Options to Westpoint

Westpoint Shopping Centre is located in a prime CBD location, surrounded by convenient public transport options, including a bus tunnel and train station, access to taxi ranks and ride-sharing services, as well as within easy walking distance from alternative Blacktown CBD carparks.

Listed below is a variety of alternative transport options that allow our customers, retailers and employees to continue to access Westpoint as conveniently as possible.

Bus

The Westpoint bus tunnel and stop is located less than a 1 min walk away beneath the Level 1 Food Court with direct access into centre. Access to and from the bus tunnel is available via the stairs, escalators and lifts located at the back of the Level 1 Food Court (near Pizza Hut Express).

Buses stopping at Westpoint include:

- 611 – Macquarie Park via M2
- 630 – Epping via Carlingford
- 700 – Parramatta via Prospect and South Wentworthville
- 702 – Seven Hills via Ellam Drive and Metella Road
- 711 – Parramatta via Lalor Park
- 721 – Blacktown to Blacktown Hospital
- 722 – Blacktown to Prospect via Flushcombe Road
- 723 – Blacktown to Mt Druitt via Huntingwood & Eastern Creek
- 724 – Blacktown to Arndell Park & Eastern Creek Industrial
- 726 – Blacktown to Doonside via Monash Road
- 728 – Blacktown to Mt Druitt via Bungarribee & Rooty Hill
- 729 – Blacktown to Mt Druitt via Kildare Road & Minchinbury
- 756 – Blacktown to Mt Druitt via Woodcroft & Plumpton
- 800 – Fairfield via Wetherill Park
- 812 – Fairfield via Horsley Drive

To access Blacktown Station, where there are further bus services available, a free shuttle bus from Westpoint departs every 15 minutes from Stand 1.

Train

Blacktown Train Station is a convenient one-minute walk from Westpoint. Sydney Trains provide direct access from Sydney's CBD on the Western, Cumberland and Blue Mountain lines to Blacktown Train Station. To access Westpoint from the train station, look south for the large 'Westpoint' sign when exiting the train station. At the base of this sign is the entry to Westpoint.

Taxi

Taxi Ranks at Westpoint are located at the Patrick Street entrance and at the On Four dining precinct, Level 4 (between Mad Mex and Max Brenner).

A free Premier Cabs courtesy phone can be found adjacent to the Level 4 Taxi Rank (between Mad Mex and Max Brenner).

Uber

Uber drivers are also available at Westpoint, picking up passengers at the Patrick Street entrance, and dropping off where requested.

Car

Westpoint can be accessed by car from all major road networks including the M2, M4, M7, Richmond Road and Sunnyholt Road. To access operational sections of the Westpoint Car Park, cars can either proceed to the main entrance at the Alpha Street/Patrick Street intersection or the access ramp to Level 4 at the Alpha Street roundabout.

Alternative parking in the Blacktown CBD can be found in the following location:

Colo Lane Car Park (4 Minute Walk to Westpoint): The Colo Lane car park in the Blacktown CBD offers both free 3-hour parking spaces (on lower levels) and free all-day parking spaces (on upper levels). Please note, all day spaces are usually filled by 8am. Reserved Parking Spaces on Levels 1A, 1 and 2A are not available for free parking. Please take note of operating hours (below) to avoid an afterhours release fee.

To reach Westpoint from the Colo Lane Car Park, head north on Colo Lane towards Kelso Lane. Turn right onto Campbell Street, then left onto Civic Lane. Walk past Blacktown City Council, cross Flushcombe Road, continue past the Max Webber Library and access Westpoint via the entry next to Jenny Craig.
